HEALTH AND SAFETY

Hessle Mount School has an exclusive and comprehensive health and safety policy which is available for inspection on request. We employ an outside agency as our "competent person", to ensure that we remain abreast of any developments and changes in this area.

Our 'health and safety policy statement' is on display on school notice boards, and a copy is available on request.

Appropriate risk assessments have been carried out and are reviewed as necessary. School trips are risk assessed individually.

Classrooms are inspected to a weekly checklist and the full premises and grounds are inspected to a monthly checklist.

We always have trained first-aiders on duty - their whereabouts and the location of first aid boxes are displayed in all classrooms and communal areas.

Fire risk assessments have been carried out and are reviewed as necessary. Fire fighting equipment is inspected and serviced annually, and staff have been trained in its correct use. An established fire alarm and evacuation procedure is in place which is displayed in all classrooms and communal areas, and fire drills are carried out each term.
