

HESSLE MOUNT PRE-SCHOOL

THE SCHOOL DAY

The Pre-School morning session begins at 9.00 am, although children can be dropped off from 8.30 am if necessary. The morning session runs until 11.30 am, the lunch-time session from 11.30 am until 12.30 pm and the afternoon session runs from 12.30 pm until 3.00 pm, although children may be collected from 2.45 pm if required. The length of the day and the number of sessions per week may be adjusted to suit the needs of the pupil, after discussion with Mrs. Black. If dropping off or collecting at a time other than the start or end of the day, please park safely on the lane and enter the grounds via the black gate and footpath that leads round to the Pre-School.

Fees - the first 15 hours attendance per week is free (Early Education Funding covers this.) Thereafter, attendance is charged at £5.00 per hour. Fees are invoiced each half-term.

If your child attends a lunch session, a packed lunch should be provided. There will be a break within each session, please provide your child with a biscuit and a soft drink which should be left in their school bag.

UNIFORM

- School t-shirt*
- Royal blue tracksuit*
- (girls may wear a pale blue checked dress during the Summer term)
- navy P.E. shorts
- black slip-on plimsolls for indoor P.E.
- trainers for outdoor P.E.
- navy blue P.E. bag*
- painting apron
- Hessle Mount bag and sun hat*

Items in italics are available in school. A spare pair of pants and socks should be left in the P.E. bag. All these items must be clearly named.

For health and safety reasons girls must wear their hair tied back at all times.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED

CORRECT UNIFORM MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES. THE SCHOOL DOES NOT PERMIT THE WEARING OF JEWELLERY, EXCEPT FOR STUD EARRINGS FOR GIRLS (WHEN A HEADBAND MUST BE WORN TO COVER EARS FOR P.E. LESSONS.) WE WOULD ASK YOU TO RESPECT OUR POLICY AND **ENSURE** THAT YOUR CHILD ATTENDS SCHOOL WEARING OUR UNIFORM IN ITS CORRECT COLOURS. UNIFORM HELPS CHILDREN TO IDENTIFY WITH THEIR SCHOOL, IS LESS EXPENSIVE THAN "NORMAL" CLOTHES AND SAVES ARGUMENTS ABOUT WHAT SHOULD BE WORN TO SCHOOL!
