## **HOMEWORK TIMETABLE**

<u>PRE-SCHOOL</u>	Please check the reading bag after arriving home
<u>RECEPTION</u>	Please practice the words in the reading bag each evening and hear your child read every evening when they receive their reading book.
<u>YEAR 1</u>	Hear set reading every evening. After the Christmas break, learn two spellings each night. Homework nights are Tuesday and Friday, 1 English and 1 Maths. Please do not work for longer than 10 minutes
<u>YEAR 2</u>	Hear set reading every evening. Learn three spellings each night. Homework nights are Tuesday and Friday, 1 English and 1 Maths. Please do not work for longer than 20 minutes.
<u>YEAR 3</u>	Hear set reading every evening. Learn four spellings each night. Homework nights are Tuesday and Friday. Please do not work for longer than 30 minutes.

## **ILLNESS AND MEDICINES**

If children are ill at school we do our best to make them comfortable. Our policy is to contact parents promptly so that the child can be taken home without delay. Should a parent be unavailable, we contact the person nominated by them on the admissions form. If your child has been absent or is unable to take part in any PE or playtimes, please send in a note explaining why.

Although it is better if children are kept at home if they need regular medication, there are circumstances when it is necessary to give treatment in school. If a child needs continuous treatment, you may come into school and give the medication yourself, or you may give written notice that you require the school to administer it. Do not send your child to school with over-the-counter medicines, as we are unable to administer these.

The children are supervised throughout the day and their safety always comes first when we are organising activities. Should an accident occur, a trained first-aider will attend. In the case of minor injuries no other action is taken, but if medical treatment is required the parents are immediately informed so that the child can be taken to a Doctor or Hospital without delay. The school will record the matter in the accident book. If the parents, or their nominated other, cannot be contacted we will call in medical help under the powers of "*loco parentis*." School work is not given during illness or holiday absence, unless a child has been incapacitated due to, for example, a fractured limb.
